

Resolution No. 2021-05

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS REGARDING THE GOVERNING BODY'S INTENT TO LEVY A PROPERTY TAX EXCEEDING THE REVENUE NEUTRAL RATE;**

**WHEREAS**, the Revenue Neutral Rate for the City of Washington was calculated as 45.181 mills by the Washington County Clerk; and

**WHEREAS**, the budget proposed by the Governing Body of the City of Washington will require the levy of a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body intends to hold a hearing and hear testimony from all interested taxpayers desiring to be heard as required by state law.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON:**

Section 1. The Governing Body of the City of Washington hereby sets a public hearing regarding its intention to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate for September 7, 2021 at 6:30 PM to be held at City Hall, 301 C Street, Washington, Kansas, and directs that notice of the public hearing be given as required by state law.

Section 2. The Governing Body of the City of Washington expresses its intention to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate with a maximum mill levy of 47.520 mills.

Section 3. The Governing Body of the City of Washington directs the City Clerk to provide this resolution to the Washington County Clerk as notice of the City's proposed intent to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate.

This resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and shall remain in effect until future action is taken by the Governing Body.
