INVITATION TO BID

The City of Washington, Kansas, is inviting sealed bids for RICE-MACT Compliance Testing on power plant engines. Bids must include any and all associated costs with this project.

Sealed proposals will be received at the City Clerk's Office, P.O. Box 296, 301 C Street, Washington, Kansas 66968, until 1:00pm on Monday, March 30, 2020. All bids should be sealed in an envelope with "RICE MACT BID" clearly printed on the outside of the envelope. Faxed bids will not be accepted. Bids received later than specified hour and date shall be returned unopened.

All submitted bids shall be honored until the work has been completed, no later than September 22, 2020. The successful bidder must have performance tests completed no later than September 22, 2020, with results submitted to City of Washington, KDHE and EPA no later than 60 days from completion of performance test date. Successful bidder must provide Notice of Intent to Test as per regulations.

Bids will be opened at 1:00 p.m. Monday, March 30, 2020, in the City Council Chambers. Bids will be reviewed and a recommendation made to the City Council for consideration on Monday, April 6, 2020.

The City of Washington reserves the right to reject any or all bids with or without cause and to waive any irregularities.

Successful bidder must supply current certificate of liability insurance.

ITEM SPECIFICATIONS

The City of Washington is seeking to accomplish:

RICE-NESHAP ZZZZ Performance Testing of two (2) Compression Ignition Stationary engines (dual-fuel) using Methods 3A and 10 with specific exclusion of ASTM Method D6522-00 (Portable Testing) to include Compliance Documentation (but not limited to): Notice of Intent to Test, Performance Test Results, Notice of Compliance Status Report with comparison from initial performance test(s), prepared for signature and sent to KDHE, with copy to EPA Region 7 and City of Washington

Successful bidder must have performance test completed no later than September 22, 2020, with results submitted to City of Washington, KDHE and EPA no later than 60 days from completion of performance test date. Failure to complete the performance test by the specified date herein, or failure to submit the results to City of Washington, KDHE and EPA no later than 60 days from completion of performance test date will result in a \$500.00 per day penalty until work is completed, subject to review.

TAXES

This project will be tax exempt. Appropriate certification will be supplied to the vendor upon request.
