INVITATION TO BID

The City of Washington, Kansas, is accepting sealed bids for relocation of 8" waterline at the southwest corner of Quivira Road (Highway 15) and Scout Avenue. This bid will be for the furnishing of all labor, materials and performing all work in accordance with the project drawings and specifications.

Proposals will be received by the City Clerk, City of Washington, P.O. Box 296, 301 C Street, Washington, Kansas 66968, until 1:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 29, 2018. All sealed bids should be clearly marked "Waterline Relocation". Faxed or emailed bids will not be accepted. Bids received after said time will be returned to the bidder unopened.

All submitted bids shall be honored for 60 days after the bid opening.

Bids will be opened at 1:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 29, 2018, in the City of Washington Council Chambers. Bids will be reviewed and a recommendation made to City Council for consideration on Monday, June 4, 2018.

The Council reserves the right to reject any or all bids with or without cause and to waive any irregularities.

BID INSTRUCTIONS

for

8" Waterline Relocation

GENERAL

This bid will be to relocate and connect to existing 8" waterline. The bid will be for furnishing of all labor, materials and performing all work in accordance with the project drawings and specifications.

The project will include but not limited to the following major category of work:

1. Connect to existing 8" waterline
2. Relocate an 8" waterline

NOTE: The electrical line relocation will be completed by others.

DELIVERY

Project completion shall be done prior to August 1, 2018. Once work has started, the contractor shall have 30 days for substantial completion. Work may begin with the written Notice to Proceed from the City of Washington.

TERMS

This project will be bid as Lump Sum, but unit prices shall be included for agency review. All items not shown below in the Bid Form such as, but not limited to, capping the existing waterline, fittings, bends, excavation, pressure testing, sanitizing and seeding that are necessary to complete the project shall be considered Subsidiary to the two bid items.

TAXES

This project is tax exempt. Appropriate certification will be supplied upon request.
