

ORDINANCE NO. 684

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LAND INTO THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS, IN CONFORMITY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF K.S.A.12-520 OWNED BY CENTENNIAL HOMESTEAD, INC. AND HOMESTEAD MANAGEMENT, INC.

WHEREAS, Centennial Homestead, Inc. and Homestead Management, Inc., owners of real property hereinafter described have consent to the addition of said property to the City of Washington, Kansas.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS:

Section One: That the corporate limits of the City of Washington, Kansas, be enlarged and extended by adding to and including in said City the following described adjacent territory and property, to-wit:

The North Half of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (N/2NE/4SW/4) of Section One (1), in Township Three (3) South, Range Three (3) East of the 6th P.M., except a strip twenty-eight (28) feet wide off of the north side of said tract, in Washington County, Kansas, subject to easements and restrictions, visible and of record.

The above described property shall be and it is included within and becomes a part of the corporate territory of the City of Washington, Kansas, and subject to laws, ordinances and regulations pertaining to said City.

Section Two. This Ordinance shall take effect and can be in force from and after its publication in the Washington County News, the official city newspaper.
