

ORDINANCE NO. 686

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER XV, ARTICLE 1, SECTION 101 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS, 1985, RELATING TO TRAFFIC REGULATIONS AND INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE FOR KANSAS CITIES, EDITION OF 2003 AND ADDING SECTION 102 RELATING TO PARKING RESTRICTIONS.

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Washington, Kansas, has determined that it is necessary to update traffic regulations for the City of Washington.

NOW THEREFORE, Be It Ordained By The Governing Body Of The City Of Washington, Kansas:

Section One: The current provisions of Chapter XV, Article 1, Section 101 of the Code of the City of Washington, Kansas, 1985, are hereby deleted and repealed.

Section Two: The following provisions are hereby adopted as Article 1, Section 101, of Chapter XV of the Code of the City of Washington, Kansas, 1985.

15-101. INCORPORATING STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE. There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating traffic within the corporate limits of the City of Washington, Kansas, that certain standard traffic ordinances known as the "Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities", Edition of 2003, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas. No fewer than three copies of the Standard Traffic Ordinance shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 686" and to which shall be attached a copy of this Ordinance and filed with the City Clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours. The Police Department, Municipal Judge and all administrative departments of the City charged with enforcement of the Ordinance shall be supplied, at the cost of the City, such number of official copies of such Standard Traffic Ordinance similarly marked, as may be deemed expedient.

Section Three: The following provisions are hereby adopted as Article 11, Section 102, of Chapter XV of the Code of the City of Washington, Kansas, 1984:

15-102. PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS. When signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall at any time park a vehicle on the east side of that portion of D Street in the City of Washington, Kansas, from the northwest corner of Lot Twenty-Six (26), in Block Three (3), in Railroad Addition to the City of Washington, south to a point directly east of the roadway that runs east and west immediately north of the City of Washington, Kansas, swimming pool as the same is presently located.

Section Four: This Ordinance shall take effect and shall be in full force and effect after its publication in the Washington County News, the official city newspaper.

Passed by the Governing Body of the City of Washington, Kansas, and approved by the Mayor, this 12<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2003.
