

ORDINANCE NO. 687

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER XI, ARTICLE 1, SECTION 101 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS, 1985, RELATING TO PUBLIC OFFENSES AND INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE "UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE FOR KANSAS CITIES", EDITION OF 2003.

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Washington, Kansas, has determined that it is necessary to regulate public offenses for the City of Washington, Kansas;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS;

Section One: The current provisions of Chapter XI, Article 1, Section 101 of the Code of the City of Washington, Kansas, 1985, are hereby deleted and repealed.

Section Two: The following provisions are adopted as Article 1, Section 101 of Chapter XI of the Code of the City of Washington, Kansas, 1985:

11-101. INCORPORATING UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE. There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating public offenses within the corporate limits of the City of Washington, Kansas, that certain code known as the "Uniform Public Offense Code for Kansas Cities", Edition of 2003, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas. No fewer than three copies of said Uniform Public Offense Code shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 687" and to which shall be attached a copy of this Ordinance and filed with the City Clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours.

Section Three: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the approval and publication once in the Washington County News, the official city newspaper.
