## ORDINANCE NO. 696

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION EIGHT OF ORDINANCE NO. 612 OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS, RELATING TO THE PRICE FOR THE PURCHASE OF CEMETERY LOTS AND THE AMOUNT OF THE PURCHASE PRICE ALLOCATED TO PERPETUAL CARE.

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Washington, Kansas, has determined that it is necessary to change the price of cemetery lots and to change the provision for the part of the purchase price of lots to the perpetual care fund.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS:

Section One: The current provisions of Section Eight of Ordinance No. 612 of the City of Washington, Kansas, are hereby deleted and repealed and the following provisions are substituted in place thereof:

Section Eight: All lots in the City Cemetery shall be sold for the sum of One Thousand Two Hundred Dollard (\$1,200.00) for a whole lot and a whole lot shall provide twelve (12) burial sites. Lots may be purchased in quarters with the purchase price based upon the part of a whole lot purchased. One twelfth (1/12) of the purchase price of a lot or part thereof shall be applied to perpetual care and eleven-twelfths (11/12) shall be for the lot site.

Section Two: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the approval and publication once in the Washington County News, the official city newspaper.
