

ORDINANCE NO. 699

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VI, ARTICLE 3, SECTION 6-302 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS, 1985, RELATING TO DISCHARGE OF FIREWORKS, LOCATION.

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Washington, Kansas, has determined that it is necessary to change the hours of the days for the discharge of fireworks or pyrotechnics in the City of Washington, Kansas.

NOW THEREFORE, BT IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS:

Section One: The current provisions of Chapter VI, Article 3, Section 6-302 of the Code of the City of Washington, Kansas, 1985, are hereby deleted and repealed and the following provisions are substituted in place thereof:

6-302. DISCHARGE OF FIREWORKS, LOCATION. It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge or set off any fireworks or pyrotechnics within the city limits within the City of Washington, Kansas, except on the 3rd and 4th day of July of each year between the hours of eight o'clock (8:00) a.m. and midnight (12:00 a.m.) upon said days; PROVIDED, the governing body may authorize any association or corporation to discharge fireworks for public display on a certain date set in the city park upon a majority vote of the governing body.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the approval and publication once in the Washington County News, the official city newspaper.
