Ordinance No. 720

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER XIII, ARTICLE 3, SECTION 309 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS 1985 RELATING TO THE RATES TO BE CHARGED EACH USER OR CONTRIBUTOR FOR THE USE OF THE SEWER SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS

WHEREAS, THE Governing Body of the City of Washington, Kansas has determined that it is necessary to raise the rates charged to contributors or users of the sewer system in said City:

NOW THEREFORE, Be it ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Washington, Kansas:

Section One. The current provisions of Chapter XIII Article 3, Section 309 of the Code of the City of Washington, Kansas 1985 are hereby deleted and repealed;

Section Two. The following provisions are substituted and adopted as Article 3, Section 309 of Chapter XIII of the Code of the City of Washington, Kansas 1985:

Section Three. 13-309. Each contributor shall pay a minimum charge per month of \$15.50. In addition, each contributor shall pay a charge of Two Dollars and Five Cents (\$2.05) per 1,000 gallons, or any part thereof, of water used as determined under the provisions of Chapter XIII, Article 3, Section 307 hereof for residential contributors and under the provisions of Chapter XIII, Article 3, Section 308 hereof for industrial and commercial contributors.

Section Four. This ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after its approval and publication once in the *Washington County News*, the official city paper.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this third day of March, 2008.
