ORDINANCE NO. 722

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING ELECTRICAL INTERCONNECTION STANDARDS, PROCEDURES, AGREEMENTS, CHARGES AND FEES.

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Washington, Kansas, finds that private electrical generating capacity is becoming a significant potential resource now and in the future, and

WHEREAS, standards and procedures are necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens and city employees for the interconnection of such capacity with the City's electrical system, and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Washington, Kansas, wishes to enact certain uniform standards and procedures for such privately-owned electrical generation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. There is hereby adopted Interconnection Standards for Parallel Installation and Operation of Customer-owned Electric Generating Facilities, together with the Program Overview, Technical Requirements, Application for Interconnection and Interconnection Agreement, all as attached hereto marked Exhibit "A", incorporated herein, and made a part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. Any customer owned generation shall be located a minimum of fifty feet (50') from any property line, and seventy-five (75') feet from any overhead power line.

SECTION 3. Each application will require a \$500.00 non-refundable application fee.

SECTION 3. All cost for enhancements due to any system degradation caused by private electrical generation shall be burden by the applicant.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption and publication in the Washington County News.
