ORDINANCE NO. 723

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 622 OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS, WHICH RELATES TO THE CREATION OF THE WASHINGTON PUBLIC BUILDING COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Washington, Kansas (the "City"), has, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-1757 *et seq.*, heretofore passed Ordinance No. 622 ("Ordinance No. 622"), which created the Washington Public Building Commission and prescribed its composition and powers, authority and functions; and

WHEREAS, the governing body now finds and determines that it is necessary to amend Ordinance No. 622 to revise the composition of the Washington Public Building Commission and its powers, authority and functions.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS:

Section 1. Amendment of Section 1. *Section 1* of Ordinance No. 622 is hereby amended to read as follows:

The Washington Public Building Commission shall be composed of four (4) members (the "Members"). The governing body of the City shall appoint Members, and one Member shall be a member of the governing body of the City. The terms of office of the Members shall be for four years from initial appointment, except that the initial term of office for two Members shall be for three years from initial appointment. In the event that the Washington Public Building Commission provides for buildings or structures that are leased to governmental entities other than the City, the composition of the Washington Public Building Commission shall be modified, as necessary, by subsequent Ordinance of the governing body of the City to conform to the requirements of the K.S.A. 12-1757 *et seq.* and any applicable Charter Ordinances of the City.

Section 2. Amendment of Section 2. *Section 2* of Ordinance No. 622 is hereby amended to read as follows:

The Washington Public Building Commission has been created for the purposes of, and shall have the powers and shall perform the functions set forth in, K.S.A. 12-1757 *et seq.* and any applicable Charter Ordinances of the City. The governing body of the City, by ordinance or charter ordinance hereafter taking effect, shall have the authority to limit, expand or otherwise alter the purposes, powers functions of the Washington Public Building Commission.

Section 3. Effective Date. This amending Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage by the governing body of the City. This amending Ordinance shall be published one time in the official City newspaper. Ordinance No. 622, as amended by this amending Ordinance, is

ratified and confirmed, and Ordinance No. 622 and this amending Ordinance shall be read and construed as one Ordinance.

PASSED by the governing body of the City of Washington, Kansas, on May 5, 2008, and **APPROVED** and **SIGNED** by the Mayor.
