**ORDINANCE NO. 744**

**AN ORDINANCE ADDING CHAPTER XVI, ARTICLE 2, SECTION 202A OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS, 1985, RELATING TO THE CHARGES FOR BULK WATER SALES IN THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS.**

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body of the City of Washington, Kansas, has determined it is necessary to designate a rate for the purchase of bulk water at the City's water plant or through a fire hydrant attached to the City's water distribution system.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS:**

**Section One:** The following provisions are to be added to the text of the Code of the City of Washington, Kansas, 1985 in Chapter XVI, Article 2, Section 202A:

16-202A. Bulk Water Rates. The rate to be paid by customers purchasing bulk water from the City of Washington, Kansas shall be as follows:

- A. \$4.00 per 1,000 gallons.
- B. An additional fee of \$100 shall be charged for the use of a meter and backflow device to be installed by the City at a fire hydrant. It shall be a \$100 fee for each separate setup.

**Section Two:** This Ordinance shall take affect and shall be in force from and after the approval and publication once in the *Washington County News*, the official city newspaper.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor, this 7<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2010.
