**ORDINANCE NO. 752**

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS; INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE “STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE FOR KANSAS CITIES,” EDITION OF 2011.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS:**

**Section 1:** Ordinance number 746 is hereby repealed.

**Section 2:** The following provisions are hereby adopted as Article 1, Section 101, of Chapter XV of the Code of the City of Washington, Kansas, 1985:

**15-101. INCORPORATING STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE.** There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating traffic within the corporate limits of the City of Washington, Kansas, that certain standard traffic ordinances known as the “Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities,” Edition of 2011, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas. No fewer than one copy of the Standard Traffic Ordinance shall be marked or stamped “Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 751” and to which shall be attached a copy of this Ordinance filed with the City Clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours.

**Section 3:** This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication in the official City newspaper.
