ORDINANCE NO. 759

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE 1 OF CHAPTER XII OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS, 1985, RELATING TO THE WASHINGTON CITY CEMETERY BY ADDING A SECTION TO ADDRESS BURIAL LIMITS.

WHEREAS, Article 1 of Chapter XII of the Code of the City of Washington, Kansas, governs the regulation of the Washington City Cemetery; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Washington, Kansas, is desirous of prescribing additional regulations concerning the use of grave spaces;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS:

*Section One.* The following text shall be inserted into Chapter XII Article 1 of the Code of the City of Washington as Section 12-118:

12-118. BURIAL LIMITS. Only human bodies shall be interred in the Washington City Cemetery. On each individual burial space in the cemetery, the following burial limits shall apply:

- a) One adult casket;
- b) No more than two (2) cremation urns;
- c) Two infant caskets;
- d) In no event shall stacking of caskets be permissible.

*Section Two.* This Ordinance shall take affect and shall be in full force and effect after its publication in the Washington County News, the official city Newspaper.

Passed by the Governing Body of the City of Washington, Kansas, and approved by the Mayor, this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of July, 2012.
