

ORDINANCE NO. 781

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN SECTIONS OF CHAPTER XV, ARTICLE 2 LOCAL TRAFFIC REGULATIONS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS, BY PROVIDING FOR AN IDENTIFICATION FLAG FOR WORK SITE UTILITY VEHICLES AND MICRO UTILITY TRUCKS OPERATED ON STREETS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS:

**Section 1.** That Chapter XV; Article 2; Section 15-209 Registration and License; Fee; Insurance; Application; Penalty, subsection (f), of the Code of the City of Washington, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:


- (6) Operate a work-site utility vehicle on any street in this City absent an orange identification flag that is located at least four feet off the ground and such flag is at least ten inches from top to bottom and 12 inches in length.
- (7) Any person convicted of a violation of any of the provisions of this section, shall for the first conviction thereof be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00; for a second such conviction within one year thereafter, such person shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00; upon a third or subsequent conviction within one year after the first conviction, such person shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1000.00.

**Section 2.** That Chapter XV; Article 2, Section 15-212 Registration and License; Fee; Insurance; Application; Penalty; subsection (f), of the Code of the City of Washington, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

- (6) Operate a micro utility truck on any street in this City absent an orange identification flag that is located at least four feet off the ground and such flag is at least ten inches from top to bottom and 12 inches in length.
- (7) Any person convicted of a violation of any of the provisions of this section, shall for the first conviction thereof be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00; for a second such conviction within one year thereafter, such person shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00; upon a third or subsequent conviction within one year after the first conviction, such person shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1000.00.

**Section 3. PUBLICATION; EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.
