

ORDINANCE NO. 783

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE COLONIAL DRIVE STREET DEDICATION TO THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS, AND CONFIRMING THE DEDICATION OF SAID STREET AND UTILITY EASEMENTS SET FORTH THEREIN, AND OPENING SAID STREET TO THE PUBLIC USE FOREVER.

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the City of Washington, Kansas, did by written dedication dedicate the real estate described herein to the City of Washington, Kansas for the use of the public forever to be used as a street;

WHEREAS, the City of Washington did by separate agreement with the Housing Authority of the City of Washington, Kansas, agree to accept such dedications, and does hereby deem it necessary to accept the dedication and open a street as herein provided;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS:

Section 1. That the Colonial Drive Street Dedication, being a street wholly within the Housing Authority of the City of Washington, Kansas, fully described as follows: beginning at a point on Washington Street 249'-5" west of the centerline of "E" Street, then south from the south edge of Washington Street a distance of 286', then west for a distance of 396' to the east edge of "F" Street, in the City of Washington, Kansas. The width of said Street is 28', together with the reservations as set forth in the Dedication attached hereto as "Exhibit A," is approved and accepted, and that the dedication to public use forever of said street and utility easements thereon shown, is hereby accepted and confirmed, and that the street shall be known as "Colonial Drive."

Section 2. That the City Clerk shall file certified copies of this ordinance in the offices of the County Clerk and of the Register of Deeds of Washington County, Kansas, to be recorded as provided by K.S.A. 15-427.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
