

ORDINANCE NO. 785

AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING FOR A RETAILER, MICROBREWERY, MICRODISTILLERY OR FARM WINERY TO BE LOCATED WITHIN THE CORE COMMERCIAL DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS, WHEN SAID RETAILER, MICROBREWERY, MICRODISTILLERY OR FARM WINERY IS WITHIN 200 FEET OF ANY PUBLIC OR PAROCHIAL SCHOOL OR COLLEGE OR CHURCH.

WHEREAS, HB 2223 amended K.S.A. 41-710, to allow for a retailer, microbrewery, microdistillery or farm winery to be located within a core commercial district as defined by K.S.A. 12-17,122 which does not meet the distance requirements as set forth in K.S.A. 41-710(c)(1) when a city, by ordinance, allows for the same;

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Washington, Kansas, has determined that it desires to allow for a retailer, microbrewery, microdistillery or farm winery to be located within the core commercial district of the City of Washington, Kansas, which do not meet the distance requirements of K.S.A. 41-710.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS:

Section One. Any retailer, microbrewery, microdistillery or farm winery may be located within the core commercial district of the City of Washington, Kansas, when said retailer, microbrewery, microdistillery or farm winery is located within 200 feet of any public or parochial school or college or church.

Section Two. This Ordinance shall take affect and shall be in full force and effect after its publication in the Washington County News, the official City newspaper.

Passed by the Governing Body of the City of Washington, Kansas, and approved by the Mayor, this 3rd day of August, 2015.
