**ORDINANCE NO. 787**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN SECTIONS OF ORDINANCE 786, WHICH AMENDS CERTAIN SECTIONS OF CHAPTER 21, UTILITIES, ARTICLE 4, ELECTRIC UTILITY OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS.**

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Washington, Kansas, wishes to correct certain provisions of Ordinance 786 previously adopted by the City of Washington, Kansas.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS:**

*Section One.* Section Three of Ordinance No. 786 which amends Chapter 21, Article 4, Section 21-403 shall be amended so that the first paragraph of Section 21-403 reads as follows:

ENERGY COST ADJUSTMENT FOR SCHEDULES R-83 AND CSP-83.  
Whenever the monthly average cost of energy (fuel, lube oil and purchased electric energy) exceeds, or is less than, 87.0 mills per kilowatt-hour sold, a charge shall be added to, or deducted from, each customer's next monthly electric service bill in the amount of .01 mill per KWH for each 0.1 mill, or major fraction thereof, by which said average cost exceeds, 87.0 mills.


*Section Two.* This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect after its publication in the *Washington County News*, the official city newspaper.
