

ORDINANCE NO. 806

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING A CERTAIN SECTION OF CHAPTER VI, ARTICLE 3, OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS, REGARDING THE DISCHARGE OF FIREWORKS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS:

Section 1. That Chapter VI, Article 3, Section 6-302 of the Code of the City of Washington, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

**6-302 DISCHARGE OF FIREWORKS, LOCATION.** It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge or set off any fireworks or pyrotechnics within the city limits of the City of Washington, Kansas, except on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of June through the 5<sup>th</sup> of July of each year between the hours of eight (8) a.m. and midnight (12:00 a.m.) upon said days; PROVIDED, that the governing body may authorize any individual, association or corporation to discharge fireworks for public display on a certain date on city owned property upon a majority vote of the governing body.

Section 2. **PUBLICATION; EFFECTIVE DATE.**

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.
