CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 4

A CHARTER ORDINANCE AMENDING CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 3 OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS, WHICH IS AN ORDINANCE EXEMPTING THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS, FROM THE PROVISIONS OF K.S.A 79-1953 (1975 Supp), RELATING TO THE LIMITATION OF TAX LEVIES IN SAID CITY BY DELETING THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 2 OF SAID CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 3 AND BY INSERTING IN LIEU THEREOF A NEW SECTION 2 COVERING THE SAME SUBJECT MATTER.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS:

Section 1. That Charter Ordinance No. 3 of the City of Washington, Kansas, is hereby amended by deleting all of original Section 2 of said Charter Ordinance No. 3 and by inserting in lieu thereof the following:

"Section 2. The Governing Body of the City of Washington, Kansas, is hereby authorized and empowered to levy taxes in each year for the following purposes, but said governing body shall not fix a rate of levy in any one year on each dollar of assessed tangible valuation of the City in excess of the following rates:

Library 3.0 mills"

Section 2. This ordinance shall be published once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper.


Section 3. This is a Charter Ordinance and shall take effect sixty-one (61) days after final publication unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed as provided in Article 12, Section 5, Subdivision (c) (3) of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case the Ordinance shall become effective if approved by a majority of the electors voting at an election held on the ordinance.

Passed by the Governing Body, not less than two-thirds (2/3) of the members-elect voting in favor thereof, this 2nd day of February, 1976.
