

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-03

A RESOLUTION MAKING CERTAIN AMENDMENTS TO THE STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, KANSAS, AMBULANCE SERVICE.

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Washington, Kansas desires to make certain amendments to the Standard Operating Procedures of the City of Washington, Kansas Ambulance Service by providing for a definition of an "Active EMT."

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of the City of Washington, Kansas that the Standard Operating Procedures of the City of Washington, Kansas Ambulance Service shall be amended to read as follows:

Section 1. That the Chapter entitled "Staffing" of the Standard Operating Procedures shall be amended by adding the following language:

The City of Washington shall pay all recertification fees for active EMT personnel employed by the City. An EMT is considered "inactive" if during any period of three (3) consecutive months the EMT has not been on the ambulance service call schedule.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective and shall be in full force from and after its adoption by the governing body of the City of Washington.
