Grant Assistance

Reimbursement grants of up to \$4,000 per property are available. Property owners provide a 25% local match. This is not an income-based program; anyone may qualify.

This residential demolition grant program will provide financial assistance to property owners for the removal of unsafe or blighted residential structures.

This program will be available for a limited time in incorporated cities located within select counties of the NCRPC service area, including Clay, Cloud, Dickinson, Ellsworth, Jewell, Lincoln, Marshall, Mitchell, Ottawa, Republic, and Washington.

Funding will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis, with a limited amount of funding available per county. For your reference, a flyer is enclosed.
