Proposals will be received at the City Clerk's Office, P.O. Box 296, 301 C Street, Washington, Kansas 66968, until 1:00pm on Thursday, February 29, 2024. All bids should be marked with "SPCC" clearly printed on the outside of the envelope. Faxed bids will be accepted. Bids received later than specified hour and date will not be considered.

All submitted bids shall be honored for 45 days after the bid opening. Bidders are encouraged to submit more than one bid, if desired.

Bids will be opened at 1:00pm on Thursday, February 29, 2024, in the City Council Chambers. Bids will be reviewed and a recommendation made to the City Council for consideration.

The City of Washington reserves the right to reject any or all bids with or without cause and to waive any irregularities.

GENERAL

The specifications that follow shall apply to the project for the City of Washington, Kansas. The City reserves the right to waive minor technicalities under this specification. Federal and State laws supersede any conflicting part of this specification.

The City of Washington is accepting bids for the revision of the current City of Washington SPCC plan.

The City of Washington has an existing SPCC plan, which was last updated in June 2018.

The final adopted plan must be compliant with 40 CFR Part 112 regulations, and must contain an engineer's stamp as per the regulations.

Inspection notification minimum one (1) business day in advance.

A copy of the current plan is attached.

Plan to be completed and submitted to the City of Washington by April 30th, 2024.
